## **Gate Code Renewals**

Gate codes are renewed every October. This year everyone will be issued a new gate code. You are required to come to the office to complete a new form with updated information. This will help tighten up the system and help with codes that have been widely shared.

All codes **NOT** renewed in person, will be turned off December 1st.

Due to the numerous issues with Gate Code breaches over the summer and the last few months, the Summer Set POA Board of Directors has made the decision to require that all of those that are enrolled in Gate Code program will be required to be issued a NEW CODE with the renewal this year.

We are hoping that having the codes changed yearly will help to protect homeowners from their codes being abused or breached.

With this being said:

- Everyone will be required to come to the office to sign the NEW renewal form in person.
- You will then be issued the new code.
- NEW Codes will be available starting October 1st December 1st.
- All OLD codes will be deactivated as of December 1st, if not already changed. This will allow everyone the opportunity to stop by the office.
- You are required to be current with all assessments and trash to renew your Gate Code.

# **Aptitude**

#### Aptitude expects to be finished installing internet soon.

If you live in an area highlighted yellow on their coverage map (on their website) it means service is coming soon to your area. These areas can be in the planning or construction phase, but if you sign up on the Early Bird List you'll be notified when it's available to be installed at your address. There is no commitment when signing up on the Early Bird List, but it can make you eligible for a free install.

#### WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE INSTALLATION?

- The Standard Installation includes most antenna mounts or outdoor boxes, the antenna or fiber equipment and cabling to your wireless router or home network.
- During installation, the technician will determine the location of the antenna and equipment to ensure the best service possible.
- Some installations require custom solutions for the highest quality of service. The technicians will always discuss this with you before beginning any work.

There is printed information available at the office.

#### How Well Do You Know the Indentures?

When you read through the Summer Set Indentures, you may realize that some of them are no longer relevant. The Board will be looking through these for logical changes and updates. These will be brought to the annual meeting for approval from property owners.

#### **Back Gate Update**

We continue to make progress on gate at McClain. The storage building has been erected, and electricity has been installed. We can move forward with camera installation as it comes with its own internet source. DH Pace/Overhead Door is the company that will install the actual gate (arm, pedestal) as well as provide the software that will be used for the stickers and cards. They are coming for another walkthrough in late October. The software operating system will become active when we have Aptitude internet available back there.
